- **October 16, 2016 to January 1, 2018:**
  - Unit Head - Lieutenant of the New Jersey State Police Commercial Vehicle Safety Inspection Unit.
  - Supervised 3 Sergeant First Classes that were one Assistant Unit Head and two that were North and South Region Supervisors. The Commercial Carrier Safety Inspection Unit field personnel comprised of a total 6 working squads that were supervised by 6 Sergeants who conducted the day to day operations. Each squad had 10 Troopers which totaled to 63 NJ State Police personnel which the undersigned supervised.
  - The Squad Sergeants and Field Troopers would work at the four (4) fixed site weigh stations or roving patrols. These Troopers would enforce NJ Criminal and Title 39 laws, overweight violations and conduct FMCSA Certified Commercial Vehicle Inspections for Out of Service Violations.
  - The Commercial Vehicle Safety Inspection Unit is also a part of the NJ State Police Special Operations Unit. Part of the responsibility was SOG and Riot control, Civil Disturbance Control, Tactical and Active Shooter deployments either within the state of New Jersey or out of State. These out of state deployments included Baltimore, Cleveland, Florida and Puerto Rico. As the Unit Head, the undersigned was involved in all the deployments and training of the

Troopers.

- As a part of the Special Operation Unit, the undersigned was an Instructor in Civil Disturbance, Riot and SOG formations, Handgun, Long Rifle and sub machine gun and Force on Force training.
